Parents proudly reported instances where their children now construct sentences inspired by book illustrations, count with newfound proficiency, identify colors, and draw connections between book content and real-life experiences. The Positive Parenting team remains dedicated to fostering these positive changes and is enthusiastic about extending our reach to more parents, assisting them in cultivating essential values and skills crucial for their children's future success.

The Positive Parenting team is actively implementing the Sinovuyo program for 2-9 year-olds and teens, engaging parents and children in Thembalethu and Rhenendaal. A significant milestone was reached this quarter with the completion of the program in Thembalethu, marked by a celebratory event. Here's a snippet of feedback from a participating parent: "I learned that understanding and loving my kids is crucial. Spending special time with them made that possible. I practiced giving clear, specific, and positive instructions, making it easier for us to understand each other. Asking about their day at school helped us acknowledge our feelings." The Rhenendaal group is currently in the process of completing the course. Our team is thrilled about the positive impact we've achieved in these communities.
